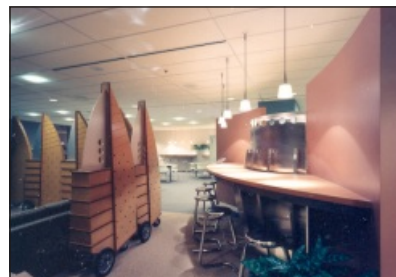

Project Details:

The project consisted of the interior tenant improvement for 19 floors totaling 525,000 sf of leasable area.

Work included Drywall, Millwork, Interior Glass, Painting & Wallcovering, all Flooring, Mechanical, Electrical, Audio Visual Systems and Equipment, Security and Signage.

Work was carried out in phases to accommodate work in occupied spaces, tenant relocations and new occupancies. The entire project was coordinated in conjunction with owner's facility staff and base building contractor and had to interface with building security system and protocols.
