This project involved the 409,000 SF expansion of the Palais des Congrès located in Montreal. The expansion would allow the Palais to better adapt to the demands and trends in the convention and exhibition market.

This mega-project posed significant challenges, which included doubling the surface area of the convention centre in the heart of downtown core due to the fact that the Palais des Congrès is situated above an expressway and subway line. Scope of work also consisted the of integration of the facades of heritage buildings within the project, as well as construct a new building and re-design existing facilities during a fully operational civic centre.
